

#### **GROWTH GROUP ELECTIVE**

Dr. Phil Long will be teaching a three week growth group elective on *Heaven and Hell* beginning today at 6:00 PM in the Courtyard Room. People have a wide variety of ideas about what happens when we die. Do we meet Saint Peter at the Pearly Gates? Do we go to some kind of purgatory for a while before we go to heaven? Do exceptionally good people get more rewards in heaven? Are there really horrific levels of hell for the most evil people? Did the church make up the doctrine of hell to frighten people into obedience? Why would a good and loving God send people to be tortured in hell? These are important questions because many non-Christians are offended by the way some Christians have answered these questions. The real problem is most of these ideas about heaven and hell come from classic literature or popular media and are not at all based on the Bible. My goal in this three-week series is to examine what the Bible teaches about what happens when we die, the nature of heaven and hell, and the justice of God.
